


# How To RECYCLE Your Christmas Tree



To recycle a tree,  
**REMOVE ALL DECORATIONS AND STANDS.**  
**DO NOT PLACE IN BAGS!**

- ❄ Place at the curb 3' from other garbage and unbundled trash.
- ❄ Trees with flocking, decorations, stands or in bags will not be recycled and should be placed with your regular trash.



## Tree Curbside Pickup

East Baton Rouge Parish **pick up range is January 9 - 21**, excluding Baker and Zachary. There is only one pickup in each area, so leave tree out during those two weeks.

## Tree Drop-Off

Sites open **December 26, 2016 – January 28, 2017**. Put trees in collection containers at the following locations:

### BREC Parks:

Independence Park, parking lot off Lobdell - between tennis courts and Liberty Lagoon

Highland Road Park, 14024 Highland Road

Memorial Stadium, grassy lot near the corner of Scenic and Foss

Flannery Road Park, 801 S. Flannery

LSU, Skip Bertman Dr. (lot across from Vet School)

## Other Curbside Recycling Guidelines for Christmas

All sizes of clean, folded, flattened cardboard boxes will be accepted inside or next to your curbside recycling cart. Wrapping paper should be placed inside cart. No tissue paper or foil paper accepted for recycling
